ORDER

As per the notification read 1st above, University had invited applications from Dental Colleges affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences for granting Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to conduct BDS and MDS courses for the academic year 2021-22.

Considering the situation of Covid-19 pandemic, University vide order read 2nd above, decided to give one time exemption to the colleges satisfying any of the following conditions from inspection for the grant of Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2021-22.

i. The colleges whose first batch of all courses are passed out and no major/minor deficiencies were pointed out during inspection conducted for the grant of Continuation of Provisional Affiliation during the academic year 2019-20 and inspections were not conducted for the grant of Continuation of Provisional Affiliation during 2020-21.

ii. The colleges whose first batch of all courses are passed out and no major deficiencies / no major deficiencies but with minor deficiencies / no deficiencies were pointed out during inspection conducted for the grant of Continuation of Provisional Affiliation during the academic year 2020-21.

iii. The colleges which will satisfy any of the above two conditions, if exempting the norm that the first batch of the students of all courses admitted in the College under EWS quota in various UG, PG courses and/or under super speciality courses (starting/enhancement of seats) were passed out.

On verification, the colleges, mentioned in the below table, are eligible for exemption from inspection as per the conditions stipulated in the order read 2nd, for granting Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for conducting the BDS and MDS courses with the intake mentioned against each for the academic year 2021-22 and have received recognition/renewal permission from Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India for conducting the courses.

The Governing Council meeting held on 17.08.2021 vide decision read as 3rd above, has resolved to grant Continuation of Provisional affiliation to these colleges for conducting Dental UG and PG courses with the intake mentioned against each, for the year 2021-22 without conducting inspection, in accordance with the U.O.No.8/2021/academic/KUHS dated 06.01.2021.

In the circumstances, sanction is hereby accorded to implement the decision of the Governing Council and to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to the above mentioned Dental Colleges for conducting Dental UG and PG courses with the intake mentioned against each, for the year 2021-22.

The colleges shall strictly adhere to the general conditions detailed below:-

- Selection, admission and collection of fee shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of direction issued by University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.
- In the light of direction issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (C) 656/1998, the institutions shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the college will be initiated.
- Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2021-2. The college has to



apply Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with copy of letter of approval from the apex bodies concerned.

iv. The Colleges should remit annual administration fee fixed for UG/PG courses for the academic year 2021-22, if applicable

v. Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
